- Debra distributed 2001 IDEM Data for E.Coli Reductions in the ICW
- Also distributed 2006 Data for Nitrogen, Phosphorus, and Total Suspended Solids Reductions in the ICW
- Validity of all these materials questionable due to:
 - 1) Sampling Location is apparently unknown
 - 2) The corresponding Flow data (in cfs) provided by USGS is “estimated” rather than actual flow rates from sampling site
- Group agreed that additional land use surveying needed (to supplement considerable mapping efforts already done by Terry)
- Additional land use mapping/surveying particularly needed in Morgan County portion of ICW
- For next meeting, Jennifer will present outline of her watershed data project and its potential application within the ICW project
- Because data provided by IDEM has been generally insufficient, and the ICW group apparently does not have the capacity to collect our own data, Focus/scope of project beginning to shift more towards a land use assessment, largely an inventory and map of livestock operations potentially contributing to E.Coli contamination.
