- Debra distributed an updated Concerns Matrix and preliminary critical area maps for each of the concerns.
- Jennifer presented her study of critical areas for riparian forest buffers. The study ranked aspects of Land Use-Land Cover by sub-watershed and their potential to deliver nonpoint source pollution (NPS) to surface waters. The ranking was then mapped, giving a visual representation of the NPS potential for each sub-watershed. Jennifer's conclusion showed the Goose Barnes Creek sub-watershed to have the most NPS potential based upon 3 of the 4 indicators. Due to technical problems, she was unable to complete the study but will report back to the committee when it has been completed.
