Pond Management Workshop Scheduled

The Johnson County Soil & Water Conservation District in conjunction with The Youngs Creek & Indian Creek Watershed Projects, is holding a three-part workshop designed to give neighborhood associations and private pond owners the necessary tools for maintaining a healthy, safe pond. Sessions will include information on pond quality, fish & wildlife management, pond ecology, pond safety, tree & shrub planting and aquatic plant management. Workshop instructors include natural resource professionals from local, state and federal agencies.

The three-part workshop will be held on Monday evenings at the Franklin College-Henderson Room, October 22nd, 29th and Nov. 5th, from 6:30-8:30 pm.
